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IBDP Program Update

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- Class of 2017: the year in review
 - 61/65 (94%) candidates earned the IB Diploma
 - High score of 41/45; average 35 (24 required for Diploma)
 - Broad-based strength vs. ROW in all subjects; improvement required in German & Mandarin SL, and Physics SL/HL
- Class of 2021: growth in the Pre-IBDP
- On-going evaluation of alternative paths through IBDP
 - Options being considered in English & Social Studies, possible implementation for class of 2019, likely for class of 2020
- 2017-2018 is an IBO program evaluation year
