### Mentor Circle Program

#### **Mentor Circles**

Harnessing the power of diverse experiences to inspire and enable WHS IB students

#### Overview

#### Why?

- Opportunity for students to learn from each other and adults
- Build connections and relationships to support personal growth

#### How?

- Two adult leaders per circle
- Four to five students per circle
- Meet every ~4 weeks for 90 mins
- Introductory meeting + 4-5 sessions

#### What?

- Student describes situations/ challenge
- Circle shares ideas based on experiences and/or expertise
- Student select 1-3 ideas to act upon
- Student shares outcomes with Circle

#### **Outcomes**

#### May include:

- Clarity re: academic and/or career paths
- Ability to overcome personal barriers and/or challenges
- Increased confidence and/or selfesteem
- Increased awareness as to individual capabilities and potential

#### **Target Audience (Pilot Program)**

- IB Diploma Program 10, 11, 12th grades
- Interested in following academic and/or career paths: 1) Software & Technology; 2) Robotics / Al / Biomechanical Engineering
- Voluntary participation; short application
