- 69/72 (96%) candidates earned the IB Diploma
- High score of 41/45; average 33 (24 required for Diploma)
- Broad-based strength vs. ROW in all subjects
 - Notable areas of strength:
 - CS SL (+2.22)
 - Math HL (+1.95)
 - Biology HL (+1.28)
 - Chemistry SL (+1.88)
 - Math SL (+1.44)
 - French SL (+1.26)
 - Physics SL (+1.11)

Proposed Changes to Bylaws

- Factors driving need to change to Booster Club
 - Growth in the IBDP
 - Shrinking RRISD / IBDP budgets relative to program growth
- Reasons to change to a Booster Club
 - Fundraising / supplement program budget
 - Expand extracurricular learning opportunities for students
 - Enhance the sense of community
- Proposed changes include:
 - Expanding purpose to fundraise and provide financial support
 - Separating the officer position of Secretary-Treasurer into two separate roles, and naming Madhu Rao as Secretary and Chunyan Pei as Treasurer
 - Adding a VP-Fundraising as an officer position and member of the Executive Committee

Motion to Adopt Changes

- The Executive Committee unanimously recommends these changes and sends it out of Executive Committee for membership vote.
- Motion: wherever necessary, to amend the Bylaws to become an RRISD Booster Club, including the separation of the Secretary-Treasurer officer role into a Secretary and a Treasurer; to create the officer role of VP-Fundraising; and to provide the Treasurer the authority to open bank accounts and transact business on behalf of the IBPA.
